Men and woman showed a difference in brain use only on the rhyming task. In both sexes, trying to recognize rhymes led to increased blood flow in the inferior frontal gyrus of the left hemisphere—Broca's area, as it's commonly called—which has long been linked to language ability. In men that was the only active region, whereas 11 of the 19 women also showed activation in the corresponding region in the right hemisphere. The women's brains weren't working any harder overall; the work was just spread out more. "The accuracy was very comparable," Sally Shaywitz says. "It may be that there are just different routes in the brain to get to the same results."

1.4 solar masses and so cannot form a white dwarf. Instead, as the star collapses, its electrons and protons smash together to form neutrons, and a neutron star is born.

As with white dwarfs, there is a limit to how much mass a neutron star can have. If the collapsing star exceeds two or three solar masses, the star's gravity overwhelms the support the neutrons provide. In a fraction of a second, the star shrinks. As the star gets smaller, its surface gravity gets stronger and the escape velocity climbs higher until it exceeds the speed of light. The star has now become a black hole.
